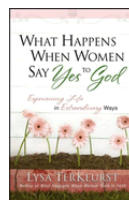

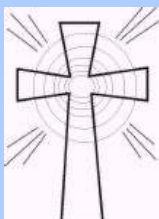

How will families get the diapers?

The diapers will be given to families that come to the WIC (Women, Infant & Children) program at Peace. WIC meets at Peace the 2nd Tuesday of each month. The families must meet financial requirements to be eligible for WIC.

Fact: Families may not use WIC vouchers or Food Cards to purchase diapers.
Diapers cost approximately \$100 per month for one child.
Food Shelves often do not have diapers available.

We hope to distribute diapers on two different WIC days so that means we need over 50 packages! Help fill the playpen with diapers.

If you do not wish to shop, monetary donations may be made and we will purchase diaper sizes needed. Make checks payable to: Peace Diaper Drive
